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Attached you will find the data report you requested, which represents numbers and rates of suicide deaths in Virginia for decedents ages 10 to 19 for 2012 to 2016. The table includes breakdown by select demographic and injury characteristics as well as select decedent and incident characteristics for ages 10 to 14 and 15 to 19 years. An additional table is broken down to show the rate of suicide decedents in this age group by Community Service Board of residence. Suicide decedents are reported based on locality of residence.

Data were drawn from the National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS), which documents violent deaths occurring within a state's borders. It compiles information from sources involved in violent death investigations, and links victims to circumstances of their deaths, such as drug and alcohol use, mental illness, intimate partner violence, and the other events leading up to and contributing to the violent death. The Virginia Violent Death Reporting System (VVDRS) is the operation and reporting system of the NVDRS within Virginia, and uses the methodology, definitions, coding schema, and software of the NVDRS. A violent death results from the intentional use of force or power against oneself, another person, group, or community. The VVDRS collects information on the following types of violent deaths that occurred within Virginia's borders: suicide, homicide, legal intervention, unintentional firearm death, undetermined death, and terrorism-related death. The data provided here is for Virginia residents only.

Data reports with relatively small numbers (20 or fewer cases) are presented in the interest of complete reporting but are statistically unreliable and should be interpreted and used with caution.

The research files for this report were created on September 14, 2018. Data may continue to be entered and updated in VVDRS after this date.
